Operation Zircon - The 2001 Hancock/Lewis Car Bombing

In 2001, a quiet suburban street in Perth was rocked by a loud explosion; a car bomb had been detonated instantly killing the two male occupants. This violent murder which shocked the community, claimed the lives of the former chief of the Criminal Investigation Bureau (CIB), Don Hancock and his friend, Lou Lewis.

Sergeant Jack Bennie, an experienced, well-respected officer with the Western Australia Police and qualified bomb technician, painstakingly reconstructed the complex crime scene and provided investigators with crucial information to assist with the prosecution case; helping to decipher a crime which brought gang violence to forefront of Perth residents' minds.
